Black River student attends supercomputer academy

Carissa Delewski from Black River High School and the Medina County Career Center participated in the Ohio Supercomputer Center's STEM Academy in Computational Science and Engineering from June 16 to July 2.

Participants of the 13-day workshop learned how to build, use and test computer models of phenomena ranging from the descent of a skydiver to the strength of a steel beam and the transport of heat through a system to the growth of an aquatic population.

The academy consisted of short lectures, individual project assignments, physical experiments and data gathering and a capstone group final project.

The program will continue through the academic year with additional work for the students and two Saturday events focused on more sophisticated approaches to modeling and simulation.

Participating students receive three semester hours of undergraduate credit and at least a half credit from their high school.
